**ENROLMENT,** In conformity to an act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, entitled "An act for enrolling and licensing ships or vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for regulating the same," *Sheldon Thompson of Buffalo in the County of Niagara and State of New York*

having taken or subscribed the oath — — — required by the said act, and having *sworn* — — — that he together with Augustus Peter B. Porter, Augustus Porter, Nathaniel Sill, Benjamin Boston and Jacob Townsend of the County of Niagara and Alvan Bronson of the County of Oswego, all of the State of New York

citizen of the UNITED STATES, sole owner of the ship or vessel called the *Michigan* of *Black Rock* — — — whereof *James Rouse* is at present master, and as he hath *sworn* that he is a citizen of the UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was by *Abijah Fosdick, Ship Carpenter, Built at Black Rock in the County of Niagara and State of New York in the Year one thousand eight hundred and sixteen*

And *Henry A. Guild of Black Rock* being thereunto appointed — — — having certified that the said ship or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts, and that her length is *Twenty five feet*, her breadth *Twenty two feet ten Inches*, her depth *Five feet & Two Inches* — and that she measures *One hundred thirty two <sup>35</sup>/<sub>100</sub>* tons;

that she is a *Schooner* — — — has *no* Gallies and *no* — — — head; And the said *Sheldon Thompson* — — — having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said act, the said *Schooner* has been duly enrolled at the port of *Buffalo Creek* — — —
