ENROLMENT, In conformity to an act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, entitled "An act for enrolling and licensing ships or vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for regulating the same," *Jonathan Sidway of Buffalo in the County of Niagara and State of New York*

having taken or subscribed the *oath* required by the said act, and having *sworn* that he is a

citizen of the UNITED STATES, sole owner of the ship or vessel called the *Union* of *Buffalo* whereof *James Beard* is at present master, and as he hath *sworn* is a citizen of the

UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was *built at Grand River in the Year one thousand Eight hundred fourteen, and altered from a schooner to Herma- phrodite-Brig in the Month of August in the Year following and again altered in her build in the Year one thousand Eight hundred sixteen*

And *Oliver Gait of Buffalo* being *thereunto appointed* having certified that the said ship or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts, and that her length is *seventy feet* her breadth *Twenty ~~seven~~ feet Eight inches* her depth *seven feet Eight inches* and that she measures *One hundred and four Tons and 31/95 tons;*

that she is a *Herma-phrodite Brig* has *no* Gallery and *no* head;

And the said *Jonathan Sidway* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said act, the said *Brig* has been duly enrolled at the port of *Buffalo Creek*
