**ENROLMENT**, In conformity to an act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, entitled "An act for enrolling and licensing ships or vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for regulating the same," *Jonathan Lacey and Ruben B. Hearse of Buffalo in the County of Niagara and State of New York*

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said act, and having sworn that they are

citizen of the UNITED STATES, sole owner of the ship or vessel called the *Hermaphrodite Brig Union* of *Buffalo* whereof *George Bayington* is at present master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was *at Grand River in the County of Genesee and State of Ohio* as appears by her Register surrendered at the Port of *Buffalo Creek* *May 27<sup>th</sup> 1818.*

And the Collector of the Port of *Buffalo Creek* having certified that the said ship or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *sixty seven feet* her breadth *twenty two feet six inches* her depth *seven feet six inches* and that she measures *Ninety six Tons and thereunto thirty fifties* tons;

that she is a *Hermaphrodite Brig* has *no* Gallies and *no* head; And the said *Ruben B. Hearse & Jonathan Lacey* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said act, the said has been duly enrolled at the port of *Buffalo Creek*

Given under my Hand and Seal at the Port of *Buffalo Creek* this *11* day of *September* in the year one thousand eight hundred and *nineteen* *Olive Forward*
