the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, entitled "An act for enrolling and
licensing ships or vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisher-
ies, and for regulating the same," Sheldon Thompson of

Buffalo in the County of Erie and State
of New York
having taken or subscribed the oath
required by the said
act, and having sworn that he together with Alvan
Branson of the County of Oswego in the State
of New York

citizen of the UNITED STATES, sole owner
of the ship or vessel called the *Erie*
of Buffalo whereof George Miles Jr
is at present master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the
UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was built at Black
in the State of New York in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred & sixteen as appears by her
enrollment this day surrendered at the Port of Buffalo
Creek
