licensing ships or vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fische-
ries, and for regulating the same," Jonathan Hedway of Buffalo

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said
act, and having sworn that he is a

citizen of the UNITED STATES, sole owner
of the ship or vessel called the *Union of Buffalo*.

UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was built at
Grand River in the County of *Genesee* and State
of *Ohio* as appears by the register surrendered
