the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, entitled "An act for enrolling and
licensing ships or vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fishe-
ries, and for regulating the same,"

James Day of Black
Rock in the County of Erie and State of New York

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said
act, and having sworn that he is a

citizen of the UNITED STATES, sole owner

of the ship or vessel called the *Gen. Huntington*
of *Black Rock* whereof *James Day*
is at present master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the
UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was built at *Black
River* in the State of *Ohio* in the year one thousand
Eight hundred and Eighteen as appears by an Register
granted at the Port of *Cuyahoga* the Eleventh day of October
1821 and this day surrendered at the Port of *Buffalo

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient
security having been given according to the said act, the said *Sloop*
has been duly enrolled at the port of *Buffalo Creek*
