**ENROLMENT,**

In conformity to an act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, entitled "An act for enrolling and licensing ships or vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for regulating the same," James Day of Black River in the county of \_\_\_\_\_ and State of Ohio \_\_\_\_\_

\_\_\_\_\_ citizen of the UNITED STATES, sole owner of the ship or vessel called the *General Huntington* \_\_\_\_\_ of *Black Rock* whereof *George Miles* \_\_\_\_\_ is at present master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was built at

*Black River* in the state of Ohio in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighteen appears by her enrolment granted at the Port of Buffalo Creek the fifth day of November 1821. and this day surrendered at the Port of Buffalo Creek by reason of the alteration of the said vessel from a Schooner to a Schooner

And the collector of the Port of Buffalo \_\_\_\_\_ having certified that the said ship or vessel has *one* deck and *Two* masts; and that her length is *Fifty one feet six inches* \_\_\_\_\_ her breadth *Seventeen feet five inches* \_\_\_\_\_ her depth *six feet six and a half inches* \_\_\_\_\_ and that she measures *Forty nine and Twenty Two ninety fifths* \_\_\_\_\_ tons;

that she is a Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ has no gallery \_\_\_\_\_ and no \_\_\_\_\_ head;

And the said *James Day* \_\_\_\_\_ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said act, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the port of *Buffalo Creek*.
