the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, entitled "An act for enrolling and
licensing ships or vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fishe-
ries, and for regulating the same," George Coit and Charles
Townsend of Buffalo in the County of Erie and
State of New York.

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said
act, and having sworn that they together with David
Burl and Guy H. Goodrich of Buffalo in the Coun-
ty and State above written are

citizens of the UNITED STATES; sole owners
of the ship or vessel called the Hannah
of Buffalo whereof Warren Dingley
is at present master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the
UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was built at
Black Rock in the State of New York in the year
one thousand eight hundred and sixteen, and
altered from a sloop to a schooner in the year one
thousand eight hundred and twenty, appears by her enrol-
ment dated 12th May 1821. and this day surrendered at
the port of Buffalo. And the said enrollment
