act, and having sworn that he together with Asa H. Boster, Nathaniel

Davis, John Meads, Ralph Pratt and William Duront of the city of Albany in the state of New
York; Anthony Day, Mary S. Gillespie, Elizabeth H. Post, Nathaniel Richards, Najah Taylor,
Ezra Slopson, John G. Boster and Joel Post of the city of New York in the state of New York,
and William P. Cleaveland and Ebenezer Learned of New Haven in the state of
Connecticut are

citizens of the UNITED STATES, sole owners

of the ship or vessel called the "Superior" of Buffalo whereof Ebediah Rogers
