ENROLMENT, In conformity to an act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, entitled "An act for enrolling and licensing ships or vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for regulating the same," *Judah Ransom of Troy in the state of Ohio.*

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said act, and having sworn that he with *George Miles Junior of Rochdale in the state of Pennsylvania* are

citizen of the UNITED STATES, sole owners of the ship or vessel called the *Wolf* of *Black Rock* whereof *George Miles Junior* is at present master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was built at *Danbury in the state of Ohio*, in the year one Thousand eight hundred and seventeen appears by her Register granted at the Port of *Buffalo Creek* on the first day of *May 1819* and this day surrendered at this office.

And *Truman Pettibone*, as by said Register appears having certified that the said ship or vessel has *one* deck and *Two* masts and that her length is *Fifty* feet her breadth *Fourteen* feet, eight inches her depth *Four* feet six inches and that she measures *Twenty eight*

tons; and *fifty nine ninety fifths* that she is a *Schooner* has *no* gallery and *no* head;

And the said *Judah Ransom* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said act, the said *Schooner* has been duly enrolled at the port of *Buffalo Creek*.

Given under my Hand and Seal at the Port of *Buffalo Creek* this *fourteenth* day of *August* in the year one thousand eight hundred and *Twenty Two*.
