**ENROLMENT**, In conformity to an act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, entitled "An act for enrolling and licensing ships or vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for regulating the same," Jonathan Sidway of Buffalo in the County of Erie and State of New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath - - - required by the said act, and having sworn that he is a

citizen of the UNITED STATES, sole owner of the ship or vessel called the *Union* of Buffalo whereof he the said Jonathan Sidway is at present master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was built at Grand River in the State of Ohio appears by her enrollment surrendered at the Port of Buffalo Creek on the Thirtieth day of September 1823

And the Collector of Buffalo Creek as by said enrollment appears having certified that the said ship or vessel has One deck and Two masts and that her length is Sixty seven Feet her breadth Twenty feet and ten inches her depth Seven Feet and an Half and that she measures Ninety six and thirteen ninety fifties tons;

that she is a Hermaphrodite Brig has no gallery and no - - - head; And the said Jonathan Sidway having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said act, the said Brig has been duly enrolled at the port of Buffalo Creek

Given under my Hand and Seal at the Port of Buffalo Creek this Thirtieth day of September in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty Three

Surrendered May 21<sup>st</sup> 1825 - New Bureau -
