the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, entitled "An act for enrolling and  
licensing ships or vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fishe-  
ries, and for regulating the same," Horace Griffin of Buffalo in the  
County of Erie and State of New York

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said  
act, and having sworn that he is a

citizen of the UNITED STATES, sole owner  
of the ship or vessel called the William  
of Buffalo whereof Warren Cly  
is at present master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the  
UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was built at Uniontown  
in the State of Ohio, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eigh-  
teen, appears by his Register dated at Buffalo the ninth day of July  
1823 and this day surrendered at the Port of Buffalo Creek

And as appears by said Register John Austin  
thereunto duly authorized having certified  
that the said ship or vessel has one deck and two masts and that  
her length is Forty feet  
her breadth Fifteen feet three inches  
her depth Five feet ten inches  
and that she measures Thirty Five  
tons, and sixty five ninety fifth parts of a ton
