ENROLMENT, In conformity to an act of the Congress of
 the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, entitled "An act for enrolling and
 licensing ships or vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fische-
 ries, and for regulating the same," Sheldon Thompson of the
 County of Erie in the State of New York

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said
 act, and having sworn that he together with Peter
 B. Porter of the County of Erie, Augustus Porter
 Benjamin Barton and Jacob Townsend of the
 County of Niagara and Harrison Look of the
 County of Sullivan all in the state of New York
 citizens of the UNITED STATES, sole owners

of the ship or vessel called the Michigan
 of Black Rock whereof Harrison Look
 is at present master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the

UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was built at
 Black Rock in the state of New York in the Year
 one thousand eight hundred and sixteen appears
 by her enrolment dated at the Port of Buffalo
 the twenty sixth day of June in the Year one thou-
 sand eight hundred and twenty two and numbered
 six, and this day surrendered at the Port of Buffalo
 by reason of a change of owners

And the said Enrolment
 having certified
 that the said ship or vessel has one deck and two masts and that

her length is seventy five feet
 her breadth twenty two feet and three inches
 her depth nine feet and two inches

and that she measures one hundred and thirty two
 tons; and thirty six ninety fifth parts of a ton

that she is a Schooner has
 no Gallery and no head;

And the said Sheldon Thompson having
 agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient
 security having been given according to the said act, the said Schooner
 has been duly enrolled at the port of Buffalo Creek
