ENROLMENT, In conformity to an act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, entitled "An act for enrolling and licensing ships or vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for regulating the same," *Harry Whitaker of Hamburg* in the County of Erie and State of New York *Mariner*

having taken or subscribed the *Oath* required by the said act, and having *sworn* that he is a

citizen of the UNITED STATES, sole owner of the ship or vessel called the *Hair Play* of *Buffalo* whereof *Harry Whitaker* is at present master, and as he hath *sworn* is a citizen of the

UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was built at the Borough of Erie State of Pennsylvania in the latter part of the Year one thousand eight hundred and Seventeen and the beginning of the Year Eighteen hundred and Eighteen appears by her enrolment stated at the Port of Buffalo on the 21st Day of June 1822 and numbered *Seven* and this day surrendered at the port of Buffalo by reason of a change of owner

And the said enrolment having certified that the said ship or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *forty six feet four inches* her breadth *fourteen feet four inches* her depth *five feet six inches* and that she measures *thirty one* tons; & *thirty one ninth* fifths of a Ton that she is a *Schooner* has *no* Gallery and *no* head;

And the said *Harry Whitaker* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said act, the said *Schooner* has been duly enrolled at the port of *Buffalo Creek*
