ENROLMENT, In conformity to an act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, entitled "An act for enrolling and licensing ships or vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for regulating the same," James Bailey of Buffalo in the County of Erie and State of New York

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said act, and having sworn that he together with Ezra Lewis, Amery Thomas, John W. Cummings and Levi Rogers are

citizens of the UNITED STATES, sole owners of the ship or vessel called the *Mittiam* of Buffalo whereof Charles Burnett is at present master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was built at

Normillion in the State of Ohio, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eight, appears by a Certificate of Enrollment, dated at Buffalo Creek the twenty sixth day of July in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty four and numbered six, and this day surrendered at the Port of Buffalo Creek by reason of a change of owners

And the said Certificate of Enrollment having certified that the said ship or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is thirty feet her breadth fifteen feet and three inches her depth five feet and ten inches and that she measures thirty two tons; & sixty five ninety fifths parts of a ton that she is a Schooner has no Gallery and no head;

And the said James Bailey having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said act, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the port of Buffalo Creek
