ENROLMENT, In conformity to an act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, entitled "An act for enrolling and licensing ships or vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for regulating the same,"

Sheldon Thompson of Buffalo in the County of Erie and State of New York Merchant having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said act, and having sworn that he is a

citizen of the UNITED STATES, sole owner of the ship or vessel called the Eagle of Black Rock whereof William Matthews is at present master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was built at Black Rock in the State of New York in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight by his Certificate of Enrolment, dated at the Port of Buffalo Creek the fourth day of October 1828 and numbered seven and

And the said Certificate of Enrolment having certified that the said ship or vessel has no deck and one mast and that her length is twenty six feet and three inches her breadth twelve feet and ten inches her depth two feet and nine inches and that she measures twenty five tons; forty two ninety fifths of a ton that she is a Durham Boat has a Prop and Forecastle and no head; And the said Sheldon Thompson having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said act, the said Boat has been duly enrolled at the port of Buffalo Creek
