ENROLMENT, In conformity to an act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, entitled "An act for enrolling and licensing ships or vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for regulating the same,"

Sheldon Thompson of Black Rock in the County of Erie and State of New York having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said act, and having sworn that he together with Isaac Townsend of the County of Erie and State of New York are

citizens of the UNITED STATES, sole owners of the ship or vessel called the Erie of Buffalo whereof James Sanderson is at present master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was

built at Black Rock in the State of New York in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixteen appears by a certificate of Registry dated at the Port of Detroit the 23rd day of June 1825 and this day surrendered at the Port of Buffalo Creek

And the said certificate of Registry having certified

that the said ship or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is Sixty two feet nine inches her breadth Nineteen feet two inches her depth Seven feet six inches and that she measures Twenty seven

tons; and forty seven ninety fifths

that she is a Schooner has no gallery and no head;

And the said Sheldon Thompson having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said act, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the port of Buffalo Creek
