having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said act, and having sworn that he and Peter B. Porter, Sheldon

Thompson, R. McPherson, J. G. Norton, Donald Frazier, James L. Barton, ~~Augustus S. Porter~~, John Thayer, Absalom Bull, R. G. Foye, E. Chapman, James Houner, P. R. Root, and William McKnight of Black Rock; in the County of Erie, and Augustus Porter, Albert Porter, Parkhurst Whitney, and Liba Gay of the County of Niagara, James Ferguson of Albany, Matthias Borden of New York and James Herma of the County of Chenango, all in the State of New York, citizens of the UNITED STATES, sole owners

of the ship or vessel called the Steam Boat Pioneer of Black Rock whereof William T. Deane

is at present master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was built at

Black Rock in the State of New York in the year Eighteen hundred and twenty five, appears by the Certificate of Benjamin Winslow, Master Carpenter

And Joseph Hill thereunto

appointed having certified that the said ship or vessel has one deck and one mast and that

her length is Ninety Eight feet

her breadth Sixteen feet & nine inches

her depth Eight feet and half an inch

and that she measures one hundred and twenty four

tons; & sixty seven ninety fifth parts of a ton

that she is a Steam Vessel has no Gallery

and a Scroll head;

And the said Augustus S. Porter having

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient

security having been given according to the said act, the said Steam Boat

has been duly enrolled at the port of Buffalo Creek
