having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said act, and having sworn that he together with ~~George Reed~~ ~~Ebenzer Johnson~~ ~~Samuel Wilkinson of Buffalo in the County of Erie and State of New York, Merchant~~

an citizen of the UNITED STATES, sole owner of

of the ship or vessel called the Milan of Buffalo whereof ~~George Reed~~ ~~Samuel Wilkinson~~ is at present master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was built at Huron in the State of Ohio in the Summer of the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty five appears by a certificate of enrolment dated at the Port of Portland, State of Ohio, the third day of September 1825 and numbered eight and this day surrendered at the Port of Buffalo Creek, by reason of a change of ownership. And the said certificate of enrolment

having certified that the said ship or vessel has one deck and two masts; and that her length is fifty four feet five inches her breadth fifteen feet three inches her depth five feet six inches and that she measures thirty three tons; and eighty one ninety fifths of a ton that she is a Schooner has no Gallery and no head; And the said ~~George Reed~~ ~~Ebenzer Johnson~~ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said act, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the port of Buffalo Creek
