ENROLMENT, In conformity to an act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, entitled "An act for enrolling and licensing ships or vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for regulating the same," *Thaddeus Jay of Buffalo in the County of Erie and State of New York*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said act, and having sworn that he is together with Robert Hunter, Nathan Brown, James S. Mathis, Joseph T. Keeler, G. P. Jeremiah, Horace Brown, W^m R. Collins, Elisha Goodwin, Truman Goodwin, Nicholas Ayrault, W^m H. Spencer, John Hartwell, John ~~Hartwell~~, Jonathan Child, and David David, are

citizens of the UNITED STATES; sole owners

of the ship or vessel called the *Seneca Chief* of Buffalo whereof *Melancton C. Wetmore* is at present master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was built in the District of Buffalo Creek in the State of New York in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty five

And *Quercus Storrs* being thereunto appointed having certified that the said ship or vessel has one deck and no mast and that her length is *Twenty three feet and three inches* her breadth *Thirteen feet* her depth *Three feet* and that she measures *Twenty six* tons; and *Eighty four ninety fifths* of a ton that she is a *Bout* has *No* Gallery and *no* head;

And the said *Thaddeus Jay* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said act, the said *Bout* has been duly enrolled at the port of *Buffalo Creek*
