are citizens of the UNITED STATES, sole owners of the ship or vessel called the *Alexander Hamilton* of *W. Rochester* whereof *Reuben Robinson* is at present master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was built at *Montezuma* in the State of New York in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty five appears by the oath of said master
