**ENROLMENT**, In conformity to an act of the Congress of  
the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, entitled "An act for enrolling and  
licensing ships or vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fische-  
ries, and for regulating the same," Hiram Pratt of Buffalo  
in the County of Erie and State of New York -

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said  
act, and having sworn that he together with Harry  
Whitaker and Seymour Whitaker both of the  
County and State aforesaid are

citizens of the UNITED STATES, sole owners  
of the ship or vessel called the Fair Play  
of Buffalo whereof Seymour Whitaker  
is at present master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the  
UNITED STATES, and that the said ship or vessel was built at the  
Borough of Erie in the State of Pennsylvania in  
the part of the year one thousand eight hundred and  
seventeen and the beginning of the year one thousand  
eight hundred and eighteen appears by a Certificate of  
Enrolment dated at the Port of Buffalo Creek the  
2<sup>d</sup> day of May 1825 and numbered 13, which is this day  
surmised by reason of a change And the said Certificate of Enrolment  
of owners 13

having certified  
that the said ship or vessel has one deck and two masts and that  
her length is forty six feet and nine inches  
her breadth fourteen feet and eight inches  
her depth five feet and six inches  
and that she measures Thirty two

tons; & twenty nine ninety fifths of a ton  
that she is a Schooner has no gallery  
and no head;

And the said Hiram Pratt having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient  
security having been given according to the said act, the said Schooner  
has been duly enrolled at the port of Buffalo Creek
