ENROLMENT, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," *Asa B. Meech of Buffalo in the state of New York*

having taken or subscribed the oath — required by the said Act, and having sworn — that he together with *Horace Meech and Seth Dwyer*, both of the state of New York, are.

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Ship or Vessel called the *Early Adams of Albany* — whereof *Timothy Capen* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built in the state of New York in the year one Thousand, eight hundred and Twenty Five.

And *John Furman*, being therunto appointed — having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and no Mast and that her length is *Seventy Seven feet* her breadth *Thirteen feet and five inches* her depth *Two feet and six inches* and that she measures *Twenty Four tons, and Thirty* — ninety-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a *Coast* — has no gallery and no head.

And the said *Asa B. Meech* — having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said has been duly **ENROLLED** at the Port of **BUFFALO CREEK**.
