**ENROLMENT,** In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," Merrit Sherman of Palmyra in the county of Wayne, and State of New York

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that Heman Norton Harry Goodman and John F. Froubridge all of the State of New York, are

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Ship or Vessel called the *Chili* of Rochester whereof Merrit Sherman is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built in the State of New York, prior to the year, one Thousand, eight hundred and Twenty one

And John Furman, being therunto appointed having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and no Mast and that her length is seventy three feet and six inches her breadth Thirteen feet her depth Three feet and that she measures Twenty six tons, and ninety one ninety-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a Boat has no gallery and no head.

And the said Merrit Sherman having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said Boat has been duly **ENROLLED** at the Port of **BUFFALO CREEK**.
