ENROLMENT, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," *Elijah Mills of Onondaga in the State of New York.*

having taken or subscribed the oath — required by the said Act, and having sworn — that he is a

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Ship or Vessel called the *E Mills* of Onondaga whereof *William Mc Laren* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn — is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built in the State of New York in the year one thousand eight hundred and *Twenty*

And *John Furman*, being thereto appointed — having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and no Mast and that her length is *Seventy Seven feet* - her breadth *Eleven feet and ten inches* her depth *Two feet and nine inches* and that she measures *Twenty Three* tons, and *Ninety* ninety-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a *Boat* has no gallery and no head.

And the said *Elijah Mills* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said *Boat* has been duly **ENROLLED** at the Port of **BUFFALOE CREEK.**
