ENROLMENT, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," *Asa B. Meech of Buffalo in the State of New York.*

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that he together with *George Meech and Seth Trayer, both of the State of New York* are

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Ship or Vessel called the *West Point* of *Albany* whereof *James Chappell* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built in the State of New York in the year one thousand eight hundred and *Twenty six*

And *John Furman*, being thereunto appointed having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has *one* Deck and *no* Mast and that her length is *Seventy five feet and ten inches* her breadth *Twelve feet and ten inches* her depth *Two feet and ten inches* and that she measures *Twenty six* tons, and *Seven* ninty-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a *Boat* has *no* gallery and *no* head.

And the said *Asa B. Meech* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said *Boat* has been duly **ENROLLED** at the Port of **BUFFALOE CREEK.**
