ENROLMENT, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," *Asa B. Meach of Buffalo in the State of New York*

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that he together with *George Meach and Seth Thayer*, both of the State of New York: are

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Ship or Vessel called the *Charles Smyth of Albany* whereof *Harriet A. Wilson* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built in the State of New York in the Year one thousand eight hundred and Twenty five

And *John Furman*, being thereunto appointed having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and no Mast and that her length is *Twenty six feet* her breadth *Thirteen feet* her depth *Two feet and ten inches* and that she measures *Twenty six* tons, and *Seventy eight* ninety-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a *Boat* has no gallery and no head.

And the said *Asa B. Meach* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said *Boat* has been duly ENROLLED at the Port of **BUFFALOE CREEK**.
