**ENROLMENT,** In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," *Daniel Peck, of Aurelius, in the county of Cayuga, and State of New York*

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that *Heman Norton, Sarvey Goodman and John T. Fairbridge, are*

*Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Ship or Vessel called the Merchants of Rochester whereof Daniel Peck is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built in the State of New York, in the year one thousand, eight hundred and Twenty Six.*

And *John Furman, being* thereunto appointed having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has *one* Deck and *no* Mast and that her length is *Seventy eight feet and eight inches* her breadth *Fifteen feet and four inches* her depth *Two feet and Ten inches* and that she measures *Twenty eight* tons, and *Nine* ninety-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a *Boat* has *no* gallery and *no* head. And the said *Daniel Peck* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said *Boat* has been duly **ENROLLED** at the Port of **BUFFALOE CREEK.**
