ENROLMENT, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," Luther Patch, of New Tane, in the county of Niagara and State of New York

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that John Dow, Ira B. Cary and John Newell, are

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Ship or Vessel called the Lexington of Rochester whereof Luther Patch is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built in the state of New York, in the year one thousand eight hundred and Twenty Five

And John Furman, being thereunto appointed having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and no Mast and that her length is seventy seven feet her breadth Thirteen feet her depth Two feet and eight inches and that she measure Twenty Five tons, and Twenty two ninty-fifth parts of a ton: that she is a boat has no gallery and no head.

And the said Luther Patch having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said Boat has been duly ENROLLED at the Port of BUFFALO CREEK.
