ENROLMENT, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," *Asa B. Meech, of Buffalo in the state of New York.*

having taken or subscribed the oaths required by the said Act, and having sworn that he together with *Asa B. Meech and Seth Thayer, both of the state of New York, are,*

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Ship or Vessel called the *Independence* of *Ridgeway* whereof *P. W. Allen* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built in the state of New York in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty five

And *John Furness, being* thereto appointed having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has *one* Deck and *no* Mast and that her length is *seventy six feet and six inches* her breadth *thirteen feet* her depth *three feet* and that she measures *Twenty Eight* tons, and *Eighteen* ninty-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a *Boat* has *no* gallery and *no* head.

And the said *Asa B. Meech* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said *Boat* has been duly ENROLLED at the Port of **BUFFALOE CREEK.**
