ENROLMENT, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," Solomon R Dowllet of Onondaga in the state of New York

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that he together with Parley Dowllet of the same state, are

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Ship or Vessel called the Dread of Rochester whereof Solomon R Dowllet is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built in the state of New York, in the year one thousand, eight hundred and Twenty five

And John Furman, being thereunto appointed having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and no Mast and that her length is Seventy Four feet her breadth Thirteen feet and four inches her depth Two feet and three inches and that she measures Twenty tons, and eighty ninty-fifth parts of a ton; that she is or Boat has no gallery and no head. And the said Solomon R Dowllet having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said Boat has been duly ENROLLED at the Port of **BUFFALOE CREEK.**
