**ENROLMENT**, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," James Graham, of Lenox in the State of New York

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that John Dewey, Ira B. Cony and John Newell, are

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Ship or Vessel called the *Constellation* of Albany whereof the said James Graham is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built in the State of New York, in the year One thousand eight hundred and Twenty Five

And John Furness being thereunto appointed having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and no Mast and that her length is seventy five feet her breadth twelve feet and ten inches her depth two feet and ten inches and that she measures twenty five tons, and seventy three ninety-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a Boat has no gallery and no head.

And the said James Graham having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said Boat has been duly ENROLLED at the Port of **BUFFALO CREEK**.
