ENROLMENT, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," Samuel Jordan of Buffalo in the State of New York

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Ship or Vessel called the Union of Buffalo whereof M. P. Whitaker is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was

built at Grand river in the State of Ohio, appears by a certificate of Enrolment, dated at the Port of Buffalo Creek, the Thirtieth day of September, in the year one thousand eight hundred and Twenty Three - which is this day surrendered.

And the said Enrolment

having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and Two Mast and that her length is Sixty seven feet - her breadth Twenty feet and ten inches her depth Seven feet and a half and that she measures Ninety six tons, and Thirteen ninty-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a Brig has no gallery and no head.

And the said having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said Brig has been duly ENROLLED at the Port of BUFFALO CREEK.
