sole owner of the Ship or Vessel called the *Loyelle Packet* of *Silon Creek* whereof John C. Stearns is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built in the State of New York in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty five, appears by a Certificate of Registry dated at the Port of *Buffalo Creek* the 26<sup>th</sup> day of June 1826 and numbered 223 and this day subscribed And the said Certificate of Registry

having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that her length is fifty six feet and four inches her breadth six feet and nine inches her depth four feet and one inch and that she measures twenty four tons, eighty nine ninty-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a Schooner has no gaff and no head.

And the said John C. Stearns having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said Schooner has been duly **ENROLLED** at the Port of **BUFFALO CREEK**.
