**ENROLMENT,** In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," Joseph Tubbs, of Salem, in the County of Putnam and State of Ohio

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that he together with John Burnham of Pomfret in the State of New York

Citizens of the United States,  
sole owners of the Ship or Vessel called the Independence of Buffalo whereof John Burnham is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Salem in the State of Ohio in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty five, as proved by a certificate of burden made dated at the Port of Cayahoga the 13th day of July 1825 and numbered 24 which is this day deposited at the Port of Buffalo Creek

And the said Enrolment having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that her length is Forty four feet her breadth Fifteen feet and three inches her depth Four feet and eight inches and that she measures Twenty six tons, and thirty one ninety-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a Schooner has no gallery and no head.

And the said Joseph Tubbs having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said Schooner has been duly ENROLLED at the Port of **BUFFALOE CREEK.**
