**ENROLMENT**, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same,"

Bradford King of Genesee in the County of Monroe and State of New York having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that he together with Moses King of Genesee and Joseph Larrabee of Buffalo both in the State of New York are

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Ship or Vessel called the *Andrew* of Buffalo whereof Joseph Larrabee is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built in the State of New York in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty six

And John Furman being thereunto appointed having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that her length is Sixty two feet her breadth Fifteen feet and six inches her depth Five feet and six inches and that she measures Forty seven tons, and Thirty four ninety-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a Schooner has no gallery and built head.

And the said Bradford King having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said Schooner has been duly **ENROLLED** at the Port of **BUFFALOE CREEK**.
