**ENROLMENT**, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," *Samuel Jordan of Buffalo in the State of New York*

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Ship or Vessel called the *Union* of Buffalo whereof *Stephen J. Hanson* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Grand River in the State of Ohio; appears by a Certificate of Registry dated at the Port of Buffalo on Creek the 5<sup>th</sup> day of July 1824 and numbered *three* and this day surrendered

And the said Certificate of Registry having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that her length is *sixty seven* feet her breadth *twenty* feet and *ten* inches her depth *seven* feet and *six* inches and that she measures *ninety six* tons, and *thirteen* ninety-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a *Brig* has no gallery and no head.

And the said *Samuel Jordan* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said *Brig* has been duly ENROLLED at the Port of **BUFFALO CREEK**.
