ENROLMENT, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of
the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and
Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and
Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," Asa B. Muck of
Buffalo in the State of New York

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act,
and having sworn that he together with John
Scott and John Bismahan both of said
State are

Citizens of the United States,
sole owners of the Ship or Vessel called the Independence
of Buffalo whereof John Bismahan
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn
is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was
built at Salem in the State of Ohio in the year
one thousand eight hundred and twenty five,
appears by a Certificate of Enrolment, dated
at the Port of Buffalo Creek the 23^d day of July
1826. and numbered thirty seven, and that she
surrendered by reason of a change of owners
And the said enrolment

having certified that
the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that
her length is forty four feet
her breadth fifteen feet and three inches
her depth four feet and eight inches
and that she measures twenty six
tons, and thirty one
ninety-fifth parts of a ton;
that she is a Schooner has no falling
and no head.

And the said Asa B. Muck having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient
security having been given according to the said Act, the said Schooner
has been duly ENROLLED at the Port of **BUFFALOE CREEK**.
