ENROLMENT, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of
 the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and
 Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and
 Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," Samuel Wilke
 son of Buffalo in the State of New
 York

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act,
 and having sworn that he together with
 Samuel Butler, of the State of Ohio
 and Ebenezer Johnson of Buffalo
 aforesaid, are

Citizens of the United States,
 sole owners of the Ship or Vessel called the **United States**
 of Buffalo whereof Chauncey Warner
 is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn
 is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built
 at Painsville, Geauga County and State
 of Ohio, during the year one thousand, eight
 hundred and Twenty six, as appears by the
 Enrolment of said vessel, granted by the Collector
 of Cuyahoga, date the 3rd day of July 1826, and this
 day surrendered at the Port of Buffalo Creek
 the said Enrolment
 having certified that

the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and Two Masts and that
 her length is Sixty eight feet
 her breadth Twenty one feet, five inches
 her depth Seven feet, seven inches
 and that she measures Ninety Three
 tons, and Nineteen
 that she is a Schooner ninty-fifth parts of a ton;
 has no gallery
 and scroll head.

And the said Samuel Wilkeson - having
 agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient
 security having been given according to the said Act, the said Schooner
 has been duly **ENROLLED** at the Port of **BUFFALOE CREEK**.
