ENROLMENT, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," *Thaddeus J. J. of Buffalo in the State of New York*

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that he together with *George B. McKee of Buffalo aforesaid Judah M. Ransom and David Hancock of the State of Ohio are*

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Ship or Vessel called the *Arculus* of *Buffalo* whereof *Judah M. Ransom* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Black River* in the State of *Ohio*; appears in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven; appears by the Certificate of *William Willard Master Carpenter*.

And *Lucius Storr* being hereto appointed having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that her length is *sixty five feet* her breadth *twenty four feet* her depth *seven feet and four inches* and that she measures *ninety three* tons, and *sixty eight* ninety-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a *Schooner* has no gallery and *Billet* head.

And the said *Thaddeus J. J.* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said *Schooner* has been duly ENROLLED at the Port of **BUFFALOE CREEK**.
