ENROLMENT, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," Sheldon Thompson of Buffalo in the State of New York

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that he together with John L. Kimble by, Walter Smith and George A. Smith of the State of New York, George Miles Jr of the State of Pennsylvania and Amos Dick of the State of Ohio are

Citizens of the United States,

sole owners of the Ship or Vessel called the Pioneer of Black Rock whereof George Miles Jr is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black Rock in the State of New York in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty five by a Certificate of Enrolment dated at the Port of Buffalo on the 15th day of July 1826. and Numbered thirty four; and this day surrendered by reason of a change of owners.

And the said Enrolment having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and one Mast and that her length is thirty eight feet her breadth sixteen feet and nine inches her depth eight feet and a half an inch and that she measures one hundred and twenty four tons, and sixty seven ninty-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a Steam Boat has no gallery and no head.

And the said Sheldon Thompson having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said Steam Boat has been duly ENROLLED at the Port of **BUFFALOE CREEK.**
