To the Honorable Secretary of the Treasury

**ENROLMENT,** In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," *Fredrick Goodrich* of *Portland Harbor in the County of Chautauque and State of New York*

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that he together with *George M. Soule* of *Portland Harbor aforesaid*

are Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Ship or Vessel called the *Liberty* of *Portland Harbor* whereof *Grant Goodrich* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo* in the State of *New York* in the year one thousand eight hundred and *eighty*, appears by a Certificate of Enrolment dated at the Port of *Buffalo Creek* the *16<sup>th</sup>* day of *May* 1824 and numbered *Sixty two*, which is this day surrendered by reason of a change of owners.

And the said Enrolment having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that her length is *Forty six* feet and *eight* inches her breadth *Fourteen* feet and one inch her depth *Four* feet two and a half inches and that she measures *Twenty three* tons, and *Twenty seven* ninety-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a *Schooner* has no gallery and no head.

And the said *Fredrick Goodrich* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said *Schooner* has been duly ENROLLED at the Port of **BUFFALO CREEK**.
