ENROLMENT, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of
the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and
Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and
Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," *George Coit* of

Buffalo in the County of Erie and State of New York

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act,

and having sworn that he together with *Charles*
Townsend, Sheldon Johnson, John L. Kimbrey,
Walter Smith, George A. Smith, Simon Fox and
Gradon G. Hall all of State of New York; *Augustus*
Jones, Noble H. Mason and *Charles M. Sidings* of
the State of Ohio are

Citizens of the United States,

sole owners of the Ship or Vessel called the *Constitution*

of *Dunkirk* whereof *Simon Fox*

is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was
built at *Sandusky* in the County of Huron and State
of Ohio, in the year one thousand eight hundred and
twenty six; appears by a certificate of enrolment dated
at the Port of *Buffalo* Creek the 25. day of April 1827. and
numbered *Three*, which is this day surrendered by
reason of a change of owners.

And the said enrolment

having certified that

the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that

her length is *Twenty* feet and six inches

her breadth *Twenty* feet and eight inches

her depth *Six* feet and eight inches

and that she measures *Eighty four*

tons, and *twenty seven* ninety-fifth parts of a ton;

that she is a Schooner has no gallery

and *Scow* head.

And the said *George Coit* having

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient

security having been given according to the said Act, the said Schooner

has been duly ENROLLED at the Port of **BUFFALO CREEK**.
