ENROLMENT, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," *Hiram Pratt of Buffalo in the State of New York*

having taken or subscribed the oath — required by the said Act, and having sworn — that he together with Joseph Neper, Alonh Cable and Hanson Swift are

Citizens of the United States,

sole owners of the Ship or Vessel called the *Fair Play* of *Buffalo* — whereof *Austin Smith* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn —

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at the Borough of *Lebanon* in the State of *Pennsylvania* in the latter part of the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty and the beginning of the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty one; appears by a certificate of enrolment dated at the port of *Buffalo* on the 7th day of *May* 1827 and numbered *111* which is this day shown to me by reason of a change of owners — And the said enrolment —

having certified that

the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and two Mast's and that her length is *Forty six* feet and nine inches — her breadth *Fourteen* feet and eight inches — her depth *Five* feet and six inches — and that she measures *Thirty two* tons, and twenty nine ninty-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a Schooner — has no gallery and no head.

And the said *Hiram Pratt* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said Schooner has been duly ENROLLED at the Port of **BUFFALOE CREEK.**
