**ENROLMENT,** In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," *Harvey Fitch* of *Chenango County* in the State of *New York*

having taken or subscribed the *Oath* required by the said Act, and having *sworn* that he together with *Alvah Cable* of *grand River* in the State of *Ohio* are

*Citizens of the United States,*  
sole owner of the Ship or Vessel called the *Fair Play* of *Buffalo* whereof the said *Harvey Fitch* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Cris* in the State of *Pennsylvania* in the year *1817 & 1818* as appears by a certificate of Enrolment dated at the port of *Buffalo Creek* on the *9th* day of *May* *1828* and numbered *five* which is this day *surrendered* by reason of a *Change of Owner.*

And the said Enrolment \_\_\_\_\_ having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has *one* Deck and *two* Masts and that her length is *forty six feet and nine inches* her breadth *fourteen feet and eight inches* her depth *five feet and six inches* and that she measures *thirty two* tons, and *twenty nine* ninty-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a *Schooner* has *no* gallery and *no* head.

And the said *Harvey Fitch* \_\_\_\_\_ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said has been duly **ENROLLED** at the Port of **BUFFALO CREEK.**
