ENROLMENT, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," *Henry Root* of Buffalo in the State of New York

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that he together with *Edward Root and Bradford King* are

Citizen's of the United States, sole owner of the Ship or Vessel called the *Andrew* of Buffalo whereof *Nelleger Hunt* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built in the State of New York in the year ~~year~~ 1826, as appears by a certificate of Enrolment dated at the Port of Buffalo Creek on the 22^d day of October 1828 - and numbered *11* - which is this day surrendered by reason of a change of owner.

And the said Enrolment having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that her length is *Sixty Two* her breadth *Fifteen feet and six inches* her depth *Five feet and six inches* and that she measures *Forty seven* tons, and *thirty four* ninety-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a *Schooner* has no Gallery - and *Bitted* head.

And the said *Henry Root* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said *Schooner* has been duly ENROLLED at the Port of **BUFFALOE CREEK**.

GIVEN under my Hand and Seal at the Port of **BUFFALOE CREEK**, this *fifteenth* Day of *May* in the Year one thousand eight hundred and *twenty nine*
