**ENROLMENT,** In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," James St. Barton of Buffalo in the State of New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that he, together, with Samuel Middleton Peter Drumagen and John Blair are all

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Ship or Vessel called the William Sell of Buffalo whereof James Sanderson is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River, Loraine County State of Ohio in the year 1828, as appears by a Certificate of Enrolment dated at the Port of Cuyahoga on the 24th day of May 1828 which is the day surrendered by reason of a change of owners And the said Certificate of Enrolment having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and one Mast and that her length is Sixty feet her breadth Twenty feet and four inches her depth Five feet and eleven inches and that she measures Sixty one tons, and ten ninety-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a Sloop has no gallery and Scull head. And the said James St. Barton having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said Sloop has been duly ENROLLED at the Port of BUFFALO CREEK.
