having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that he together with Charles Townsend Water Smith, LeCap, Malory, J. Tenker, E. Tenker, J. McLaughlin, John F. Wright, W. Root, A. Kellogg, Sheldon Thompson & John I. Remberly are

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Ship or Vessel called the Beaver of Buffalo whereof

is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was was built at Erie in the State of Pennsylvania in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty and raised upon in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty hundred and twenty sworn upon by a certificate of enrolment dated at the port of Buffalo on the 21st day of July 1856 And "the said enrolment

having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and two Mast and that her length is fifty six feet her breadth seven feet and six inches her depth five feet & three inches and that she measures forty four tons, ninety-fifth parts of a ton; that she is A Schooner has no Gallery and Billit head.

And the said George Root having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said Schooner has been duly **ENROLLED** at the Port of **BUFFALO CREEK**.
