ENROLMENT, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," *Thomas B Campbell*

having taken or subscribed the *Oath* required by the said Act, and having *Sworn* that he together with *Elephat L Tenker Joseph White for John W Whorton Norman Hilby Joseph Jamesworth Lyman Ridington Elias Mallory Aaron Ramsey William Britton Howell Bidel Jonathan Cap Atkinson Beshop Asa Farmworth Asah Lyon Jipe Brooks Hozekiah Tenken Moses Mack A. Plumb &c Henry Baker Samuel Barnt Samuel a Brown George T Camp Elsie Foot Gustav J Rudlong Thomas B Campbell Benjamin Evans John Hilroy Royal Gus Judah Tracy John B Johnson of the county of Chitauque in the State of New York sole owner of the Ship or Vessel called the *William Peacock* Smith Buffalo for B Meek of New York & Rufus Stone of New York*

of *Portland* whereof the said *John Flechaity* is at present Master; and, as he hath *Sworn*

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was *Built at Portland Harbor in the County of Chitauque and State of New York in the year 1829* appears by a certificate of Record dated at the Port of Buffalo Creek the 20th May 1829 which is this day surrendered and by reason of a change of owners and the said certificate of Record having certified that

the said Ship or Vessel has *one* Deck and *two* Masts and that her length is *one hundred and two feet* her breadth *Nineteen feet* her depth *Seven and one half feet* and that she measures *one hundred and twenty* tons, and no *ninty-fifth* parts of a ton; that she is a *Steamer* has *no* Gallery and *Scroll* head.

And the said *Thomas B Campbell* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said *Vessel* has been duly **ENROLLED** at the Port of **BUFFALOE CREEK.**
