ENROLMENT, In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," Roswell Mackabee

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Act, and having Sworn that Roswell Mackabee of the County Sandusky & State of Ohio & Jand Z Jennings of the County of Erie State of Pennsylvania are

Citizen of the United States, sole owner & of the Ship or Vessel called the Liberty of Buffalo whereof Roswell Mackabee is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo in the State of New York in the year one thousand eight hundred and Eighteen as appears by a certificate of Register dated at the Port of Buffalo on the fourteenth day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine which is the day Sunday - the said Register

having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and two Mast and that her length is forty six feet & eight inches her breadth fourteen feet and one inch her depth four feet and two inches and one half and that she measures twenty three tons, and twenty seven ninty-fifth parts of a ton; that she is a Schooner has no Gallery and no head.

And the said Roswell Mackabee having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said has been duly ENROLLED at the Port of **BUFFALOE CREEK.**
